The trail weaves through towering trees, ferns, and moss, and a long bridge complements the picturesque journey. Informative signboards along the way offer valuable insights into the Pong Dueat Hot Spring and the diverse flora present.

Continue the adventure to the captivating Pai district, following the historic World War II road, which navigates numerous sharp curves, offering stunning vistas of the majestic mountains. As evening sets in, delve into the local lifestyle on the bustling walking street. Wander along and discover an array of handmade products, clothing, jewelry, baskets, and charming souvenirs. The street is also dotted with various international and Thai restaurants, beckoning you to savor a delectable culinary experience. Venture to the enchanting Santichon village, inhabited by Yunnan Chinese people who settled here long ago. Not far from Santichon village, the Yun Lai viewpoint awaits, offering breathtaking vistas of Pai city, nestled amid lush paddy fields and a rugged mountain range. Whether it's winter or the rainy season, a mystical sea of mist blankets the area, creating a captivating sight. Discover the captivating Wat Phra That Mae Yen Temple, perched on the elevated hill of Mae Yen village. From its summit, indulge in panoramic views of Pai city, particularly during sunrise and sunset. As the golden sunlight bathes the horizon, the majestic mountain ranges create a truly unforgettable and picturesque setting. Explore the Memorial Bridge, which bears historical significance from the Second World War. Originally used as a route to transport troops and arms into Myanmar, this bridge holds memories of the past. Although it has been replaced by a standard bridge, it remains a popular spot for tourists to capture photographs and honor its historical legacy while visiting Pai District.

Continue the journey to the captivating Pai Canyon, also known as Kong Lan, a natural wonder shaped by soil subsidence and erosion, forming deep cliffs and ridge-like ridges across an area of more than 3 acres. The surrounding landscape features a mixed deciduous forest with diverse plant life, creating a mesmerizing setting. The narrow and steep trails along the ridges offer an exhilarating experience as you explore the canyons with breathtaking views of the villages

and farms below, amidst the backdrop of towering mountains. Visit the Merit Bridge, "Khokuso," a winding bamboo bridge spanning picturesque rice fields with stunning mountain scenery in the background.
