The waterfall cascades gracefully into the basin below, standing tall at an impressive height of 70 meters. Throughout the year, its waters flow steadily, creating a serene and picturesque scene. During the rainy season, the interplay of sunlight and water droplets creates frequent rainbows, adding an enchanting touch to the already awe-inspiring sight. The lush greenery surrounding the waterfall and the thunderous roar of the cascading water create a symphony of natural sounds that enhances the magical atmosphere. Visitors can take a refreshing break by the falls, enjoying the cool mist and the tranquil ambiance.

Next, marvel at the architectural wonders of the Twin Royal Pagodas, Napamethanidol and Napapolpumisiri, perched atop a high hill within Doi Inthanon National Park. Phra Mahathat Napamethanidol was built to honor and pay homage to Phra Bat Somdet Phra Paramintra Maha Bhumibol Adulyadej Rama IX during the auspicious celebration of His Majesty the King's 5th cycle birthday in 1987. Similarly, Phra Mahathat Naphaphonphumisiri was constructed as an offering to Her Majesty Queen Sirikit during the celebrations of Her Majesty the Queen's 5th cycle birthday in 1992. The pagodas are set amidst splendid winter flower gardens and a diverse array of plants, creating a picturesque and serene setting. With cool weather prevailing throughout most of the year, this spot offers panoramic views that are considered among the most beautiful viewpoints in Chiang Mai. The tranquil atmosphere and the meticulously landscaped gardens provide a perfect backdrop for reflection and photography.

Venture further to Doi Inthanon, the highest peak in Thailand, soaring at an altitude of 2,565 meters above sea level. As part of the Thanon Thongchai Mountain range stretching from the Himalayas, this area boasts abundant biodiversity and varied climates. As you ascend the mountain, you'll traverse through different ecological zones, from dense rainforests to majestic pine forests and mixed forests, each offering a unique and captivating natural experience. Along the way, you'll encounter a variety of flora and fauna, including rare orchids, colorful birds, and, if you're lucky, even some elusive wildlife. At the summit, visitors are rewarded with magnificent panoramic scenery, a testament to Doi Inthanon's irresistible allure that attracts people from all corners of the world.

Afterward, continue your journey to Bua Tong Waterfall, a unique limestone cascade nestled within lush, pristine forest. The area is filled with towering trees, blending tropical evergreen and mixed deciduous forest that remains green and humid year-round. Visitors can take a leisurely walk along nature trails or relax at scenic viewpoints overlooking the hills and flowing streams. The waterfall features multiple tiers of smooth white limestone, reaching a total height of approximately 100 meters. The mineral-rich water coats the rocks with calcium carbonate, creating a non-slippery surface that allows visitors to safely climb up and down the falls—an exhilarating and rare experience. The water stays cool and clear throughout the year, accompanied by the soothing sounds of nature, making Bua Tong Waterfall an ideal destination for those seeking both adventure and tranquility in the heart of nature.

Next, head to Kingkong Smile Zipline in Doi Saket District, Chiang Mai—one of the region's most popular adventure attractions. Here, you'll find a variety of thrilling outdoor activities set amidst lush green forests and panoramic mountain views. The park offers something for everyone, from adrenaline seekers to families. Soar through the treetops on the zipline, take on the challenge of abseiling from great heights, walk across the breathtaking Glass Bridge for a 360-degree view, or cross the Sky Bridge and Iron Bridge suspended above the forest canopy. For nature lovers, there's the Nature Trail Walkway—a serene path through the greenery—and the Spiral Staircase, a beautifully designed tower offering sweeping views of the surrounding landscape. Every activity at Kingkong Smile Zipline combines excitement, safety, and natural beauty, making it a must-visit destination for anyone seeking adventure and unforgettable scenery in Chiang Mai.

**DAY 04** Chiang Mai - Chiang Rai: Wat Prathat Doi Suthep Temple / Mae Tang River Rafting / Chiang Rai Night Bazaar (Hotel / Breakfast / Lunch)

The fourth day of your adventure begins with a journey from Chiang Mai city to Wat Phra That Doi Suthep, a revered temple nestled atop Doi Suthep Mountain. The architectural brilliance of Wat Phra That Doi Suthep blends Lanna and traditional Thai styles, adorned with intricate golden decorations, ornate wooden carvings, and striking pagodas. The main attraction—a revered chedi housing the sacred relic—is said to radiate great spiritual power. From the temple’s vantage point, sweeping panoramic views of Chiang Mai city and its surrounding countryside are truly breathtaking.

After admiring the art and beauty of Wat Phra That Doi Suthep, continue your journey to Mae Taeng District for an exhilarating white-water rafting experience on the Mae Taeng River. This thrilling activity perfectly combines fun, challenge, and the beauty of nature. The river winds through valleys and lush forests, stretching for several kilometers with rapids ranging from gentle flows for beginners to more intense currents for experienced rafters. Rafting here is closely supervised by professional staff to ensure the safety of all participants. Along the way, rafters will encounter alternating stretches of rushing currents and calm waters, enjoy views of mountains and forests, and hear the sounds of nature up close—making every moment filled with excitement and wonder. White-water rafting on the Mae Taeng River is an unforgettable experience for families seeking adventure in Chiang Mai’s stunning natural surroundings.

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Depart from Chiang Rai city and journey to the enchanting Doi Tung Palace, also known as the Doi Tung Royal Villa. Perched at an elevation of 1,200 meters above sea level, it was constructed in 1987 on the forested slopes of Doi Tung Mountain in Mae Fah Luang Subdistrict, Mae Fah Luang District. This serene retreat once served

as the residence of Her Royal Highness Princess Srinagarindra, the beloved Princess Mother of Thailand. The palace is a striking fusion of Swiss chalet and traditional Lanna architectural styles. Crafted with elegance and care, the structure features exquisite wood carvings by skilled northern Thai artisans, adorning its gables, eaves, and window frames with intricate details. Doi Tung Palace was established as part of the Princess Mother's royal initiative to restore and rehabilitate areas ravaged by deforestation and opium cultivation. Her vision gave rise to the Doi Tung Development Project, a sustainable development program designed to improve the quality of life for local communities through education, agriculture, and self-sufficiency. Just steps from the palace lies the Mae Fah Luang Garden, a vibrant sanctuary of color and fragrance. This beautifully landscaped botanical haven showcases a stunning array of flowers and plants from around the world. As the seasons change, so too does the garden's appearance—bursting into life with the soft pastels of spring or glowing with the fiery tones of autumn. It is a living canvas that delights the senses and provides a peaceful retreat from everyday life. A visit to Doi Tung Palace and the Mae Fah Luang Garden is more than a scenic experience—it is a journey through Thailand's natural beauty, architectural elegance, and the enduring legacy of a royal mission that transformed lives and landscapes alike.

Next, journey to the bustling Mae Sai District, Thailand's northernmost point and a dynamic gateway to Myanmar. Situated along the Mae Sai River, this vibrant district is marked by the Mae Sai Bridge, which connects the two countries. The Golden Triangle was once infamous as a global center for opium cultivation and trade, earning the nickname "Black Gold Triangle" due to the immense wealth generated by the illicit industry. Though the opium fields have long vanished, the stories of that era remain etched into the landscape, offering a glimpse into a complex and turbulent past. One of the most striking landmarks here is the Golden Triangle Buddha—a magnificent bronze statue adorned with topaz. Weighing an impressive 69 tons, with a lap width of 10 meters and a height of 15 meters, this serene figure stands as a symbol of peace and transformation, honoring the region's journey from conflict to cultural preservation.

From the Golden Triangle, embark on a scenic cruise along the mighty Mekong River, one of the world's most vital and storied waterways. As your boat glides across its surface, you'll be immersed in the breathtaking beauty of the riverbanks, where lush vegetation, quiet villages, and distant hills create a tranquil and picturesque panorama. The Mekong has long served as a lifeline for the people of Southeast Asia, shaping civilizations, supporting agriculture, and fostering trade and cultural exchange across borders.
